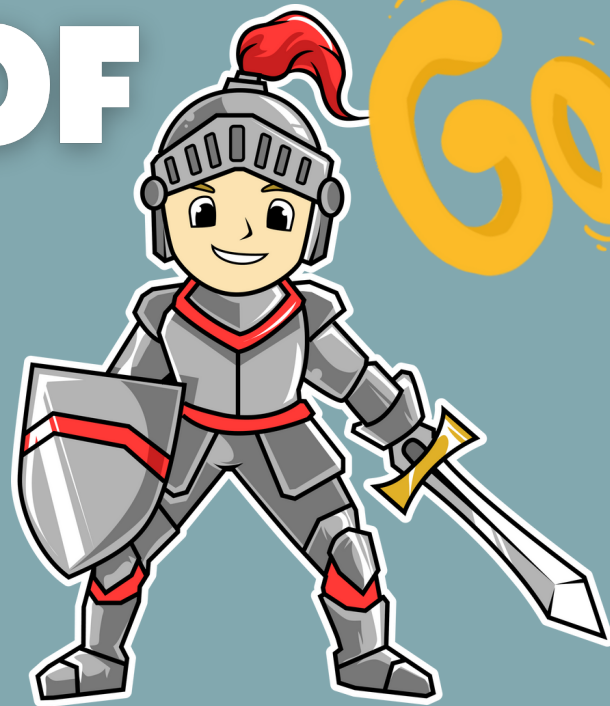

Introduction

Armor of God: A Kids Guide to Standing Strong in Their Faith is a devotional series to help kids understand who their enemy is and how to stand against his attacks by putting on each piece of the armor of God. This 10-lesson devotional will help your kids understand the spiritual battle in a simple and practical way.

How to Use:

The best way to use this devotional is to read through and discuss one lesson per week with your children. Each devotional discusses a verse from Ephesians 6:10-18 and provides a cut-and-paste activity, prayer, and memory verse challenge, laying the foundation for your kids to stand strong against temptation. *The Armor of God Prayer*, written as a poem, is also provided to help your kids remember each piece of armor and what each one means.

Lesson ONE: Be Strong in the Lord



*“Finally, be strong in the Lord and in His mighty power.”
Ephesians 6:10 (NIV)*

Instructions

Read through the devotional and cut and paste the objects on the activity page.

Read Ephesians 6:10 (see above)

? Who makes us strong?

God can make us strong.

? How can God make us strong?

1. When we know God is our loving Father and King, we will be strong in His love. He protects us from our enemy because He loves us. Let's cut and glue the crown in the thought bubble to remember that He is our king and protects us.
2. When we read our Bible, God makes us strong! We will know how to follow God's ways! Let's cut and glue the Bible in the thought bubble to remember that God's Word, the Bible, makes us strong.
3. When we pray, God makes us strong! We can call on God for help, and He will help us when we are scared, sad, or mad. Let's cut and glue the praying hands in the thought bubble to remember we can always ask God for help in prayer.

Dear Jesus, thank you that you give us strength through your love, the Bible, and prayer! Help us to find our strength in you. Amen

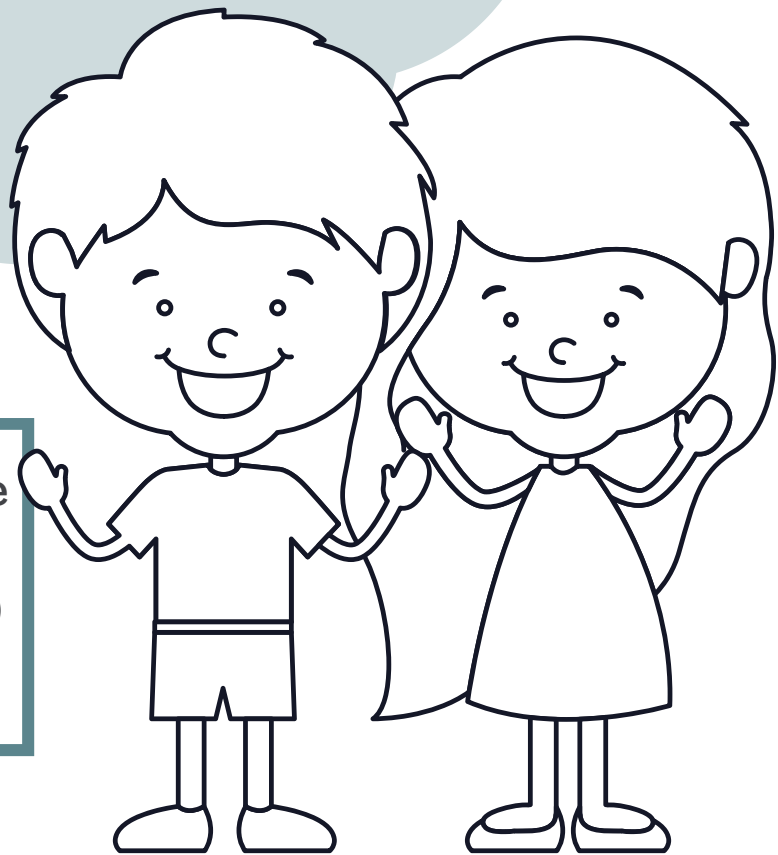
Recite the Bible verse each day adding gestures for some of the words.

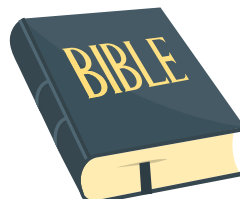
